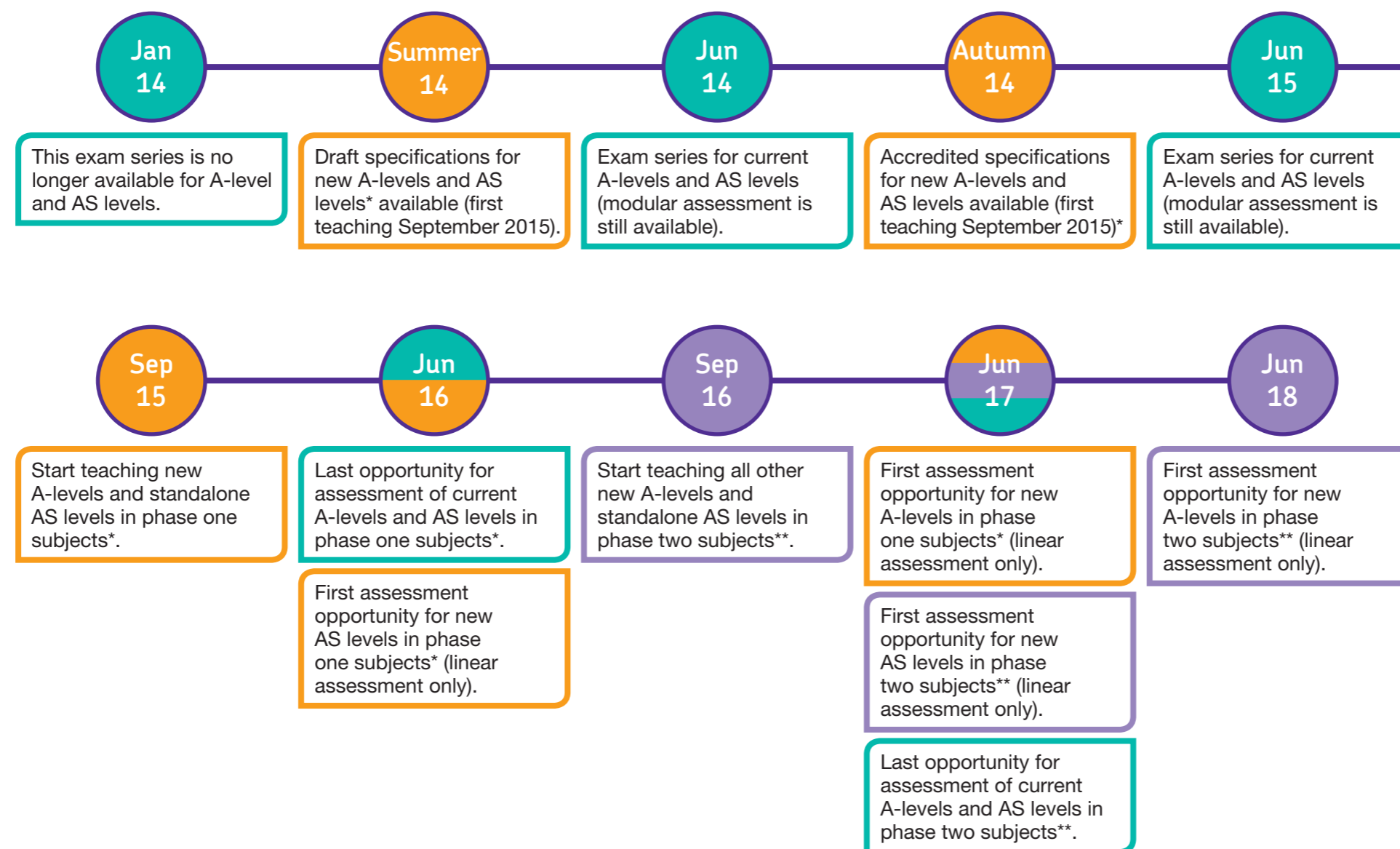


# A-level Timeline for changes

A-levels and AS levels are being reformed in phases – phase one subjects are English Language, English Literature, English Language and Literature, the Sciences, History, Psychology, Art and Design, Sociology, Business Studies, Economics and Computing. These subjects will be reformed for first teaching in 2015.

Phase two subjects are Mathematics, Languages and Geography\*\*\* and will be reformed for first teaching in September 2016.

AS levels will be stand-alone qualifications and will no longer contribute to A-levels.

\* The subjects being reformed for first teaching in September 2015 are English Language, English Literature, English Language and Literature, the Sciences, History, Psychology, Art and Design, Sociology, Business Studies, Economics and Computing. These are referred to as phase one subjects.

\*\* Mathematics, Languages and Geography will be reformed for first teaching in September 2016. These are referred to as phase two subjects.

\*\*\* A-level Geography was moved to phase two in February 2014
