## FOFS 100 Club

The 100 Club is a fund raising lottery organised by the Friends of Farmor's School Committee to help raise money to support the school as well as giving entrants the chance to win cash prizes regularly.

Anyone over the age of 16 can become a member of the Club and it is not restricted to 100 members.

Each subscriber pays an annual fee of £12 and is allotted a draw number. You can purchase more than one number if you want.

The regular draws will be made at the end of June, September, November, February and April and a special draw in December.

Cash prizes for the year are awarded to the sum of 50% of the annual subscriptions raised and divided over the 6 draws. The remaining 50% will be allocated to FOFS to donate to the school. The amount people can win depends on the numbers in the Club but, for example, if we got exactly 100 members in the year the prize draws would result in:

February/April/June/September/November draws:

1st Prize: £60 2nd Prize: £30

The December draw:

1st Prize: £100 2nd Prize: £50

Prize winners will be contacted by phone/email and the prizes will be sent to them. A list of winners will also be posted on the school website.

If you wish to join the Club please complete the form attached and return it to me by email or to reception at school. Ideally we would like people to pay through Parentpay or set up a Standing Order to simplify the administration, but if you wish to pay by cheque please deliver to the Finance Office with your subscription as soon as possible.

The 100 Club is fully registered with The Cotswold District Council, Trinity Road, Cirencester in accordance with Schedule 1 of The Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976, and to whom quarterly returns are made. The decision of the FOFS Committee shall be final in all matters requiring adjudication. The FOFS Committee shall also have the power to amend or revoke these rules at their absolute discretion with such reasonable notice to the 100 Club members as is necessary.
