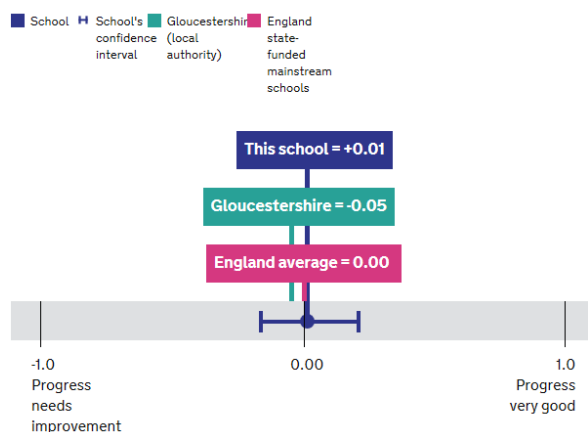


Farmor's School KS4 Results Summary 2016

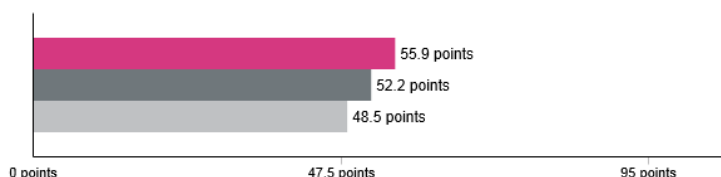
Progress 8 score (2016)

The chart below shows how the school compares on Progress 8 against the England and local authority averages. This score shows how much progress pupils at this school made between the end of key stage 2 and the end of key stage 4, compared to pupils across England who got similar results at the end of key stage 2. A score of zero means that students made the expected progress when compared to children with similar starting points nationally.



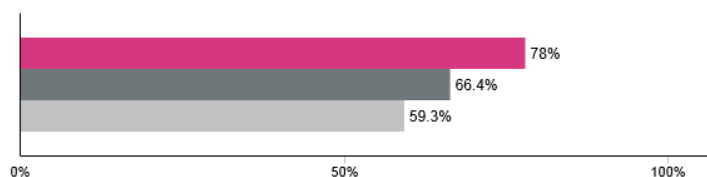
Attainment 8 score (2016)

The chart below shows how the school compares on Attainment 8 against the England and local authority averages. The school Attainment 8 score for 2016 is 55.9 points per student (pink bar) which compares to 52.2 for Gloucestershire (dark grey bar) and 48.5 nationally (light grey bar).



Percentage of students achieving a C grade pass or better in GCSE English and Maths (2016)

The diagram below shows the percentage of students achieving a C grade pass or better in GCSE English and Maths for 2016. At farmor's School, the average was 78% (pink bar) which compares to 66.4% for Gloucestershire (dark grey) and 59.3% nationally (light grey).



Percentage of students passing the EBacc (2016)

The English Baccalaureate is not a test or qualification; it is a measure used to provide information about a particular range of qualifications. A pupil is considered to have 'achieved' the English Baccalaureate if they got a grade C or better in the following subjects: English, maths, sciences, a language and either history or geography. The diagram below shows the school Percentage of students achieving the EBacc for 2016 which is 36% (pink bar) for Farmor's School. This compares to 26.5% for Gloucestershire (dark grey) and 23.1% nationally (light grey).
