Year 11 GCSE Drama Practical Exam

Dear Parents/Carers,

The Year 11 GCSE Drama practical exam takes place after school on **Friday 6th May**. We recommend that all of our Year 10 GCSE Drama students watch the exam performances so they can see what will be expected of them when they undertake Unit 3 next year.

The Year 11 students will perform extracts from three plays – *The House of Bernarda Alba* by Federica Garcia Lorca, *A Taste of Honey* by Shelagh Delaney and *Yellow Moon* by David Greig. The students will be assessed by an Examiner from the Edexcel exam board on their skills in acting, lighting, sound, set, props and costume design. It will be a really valuable experience for the Y10 GCSE students.

The Year 10 students will be required to come to the school theatre at **3.00pm**, and the exam will finish at approximately **7.00pm**. A break will be provided. It will be a long day, so I recommend that students bring an extra packed lunch, snacks and water to keep themselves refreshed. They will not be allowed out of school to purchase food.
