Following the information evening last Thursday, I am sending this information out to confirm everything that was covered in the meeting.

- Monday 17th July: Arrive at school no later than 8.45am, leave by 9.30am.
- Wednesday 19th July: Return to school approximately 4.15pm. Will message if delayed.
- Travel on luxury coaches with loos
- Will need a packed lunch for the first day.
- 8 members of Farmor's staff going, all tutors, myself, Mr Eckersley and Mr Robbins (TA)
- Students will be in single sex bedrooms of four and activity groups of up to 12.
- All activities run by PGL Staff. Farmor's staff will deal with pastoral affairs.
- Insurance is provided by the school for travel and PGL for the stay.
- Kit list attached to this message. Please make sure bags are labelled. Bedding is **NOT** required.
- Barton Hall is a secure, fenced in site. There will be other schools there at the time.
- NO mobile phones, electronic games or jewellery and other valuables will be permitted.

- All medical conditions, allergies and dietary requirements will be informed to PGL in advance and catered for. Medication must be placed in a separate named bag with clear dosage/timing instructions and handed to me prior to departure. This includes paracetamol.

- Outstanding behaviour is anticipated – you will be required to collect your child or cover the cost of transport if your child has to be sent home.
