COLLECTIVE ACT OF WORSHIP

Worship is conducted through School Assemblies which are held as frequently as is possible within the confines of the school site. The intention is that these Assemblies should reflect the requirements of the law through a varied, meaningful and reflective programme. The law requires us to focus on Christianity alongside other religions.

The content of each assembly is pre-planned, with a central bank of material to be used by the Head of Year or Senior Leadership team. Outside speakers are invited when appropriate.

Assemblies in each year follow a theme:

- Y7 Religion and Religious festivals
- Y8 Morality and Responsibility
- Y9 Global issues
- Y10 Spiritual
- Y11 Social

The Assemblies should also be an opportunity to praise and celebrate school activities and successes. Students' participation in Assemblies through music, drama and other activities is encouraged.

The Assembly structure is published each term and includes a minimum of one year group assembly per week.
